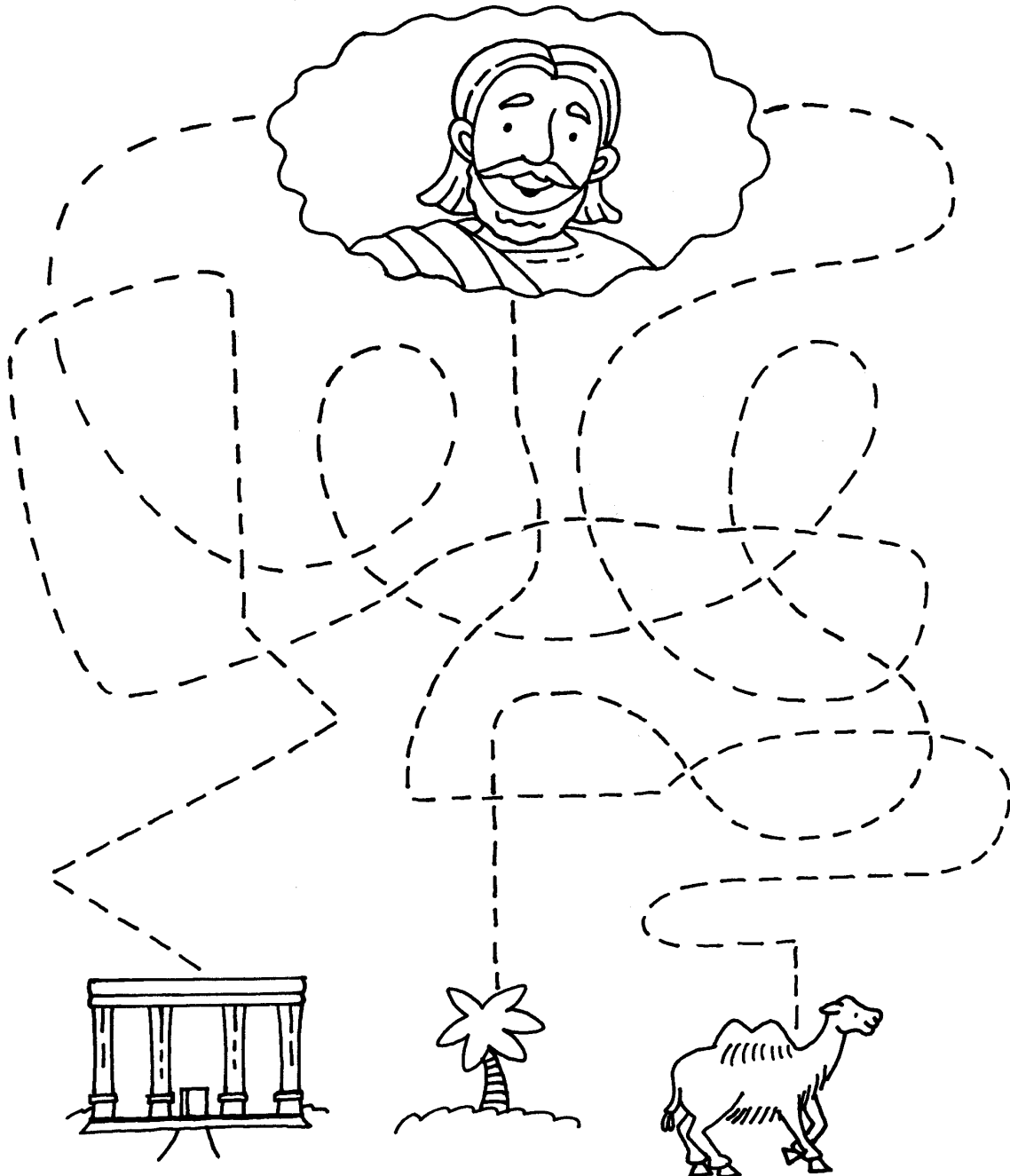
Come and See
