





Dear Faith Family,

Friendship is so important to our faith. I know it may have been hard for a lot of us during this pandemic, but it's time like this that helps us to understand the beauty of what a strong Christian friendship does for our faith.

When we read John 11 (the Year A scrutiny readings), we should be taken aback by the beauty of the miracle performed. We should also be taken aback by the compassion and the love that Jesus had for Lazarus. We should also be in awe with the fact that God loves us as much as he loves Lazarus, and we should also be in awe of His willingness to die and rise from the dead just for us, which we will be remembering during Holy Week.

One thing we may glance past, though, is the idea that Mary and Martha were the ones that helped bring Jesus to the dead.

How many friends do we have that have had the courage to pray for us? How many friends do we have that can recognize that we are spiritually under the weather and are willing to bring Christ back to us?

I think it's been a common trend throughout this pandemic, friendships have looked different this past year. Being unable to see each other in the same way as before has brought a lot of strain on people's relationships. The ones who love us did not give up on us, even when things weren't the same, but the ones who loved us have always been willing to bring Christ to us, especially when we are ill.

How can we be like Mary and Martha this Lent? The odds are, we have friends who are going through difficulties right now. We may also have friends who have had a difficult spiritual journey for the past year. Let's be like Lazarus' sisters, and bring our Lord to them. That is one of the most effective ways for those who are ill to recognize that God still loves them infinitely, even if they perceive themselves as ill or dying spiritually.

If our Lord can raise someone from the dead, I guarantee that he can help those of us who feel like their spirits have died. Let's be the ones who bring our God to our loved ones in need.

Becoming Catholic

The Sacraments

The seven sacraments are essential and to the Catholic way of life. They are marvelous gifts from God and might be described as blessed grace-filled moments along our earthly journey. Each sacrament is an encounter with the risen Jesus. Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist are called the Sacraments of Christian Initiation because they incorporate us into the saving death and resurrection of Jesus (the "Paschal Mystery"). Baptism and Confirmation are not repeatable because they give us an "indelible mark" as a member of the Body of Christ. Eucharist, the high point of our initiation, can be received every day, but at least once a week on Sunday. The Eucharist ("Holy Communion") nourishes us and strengthens us to live as disciples of Jesus. Holy Communion is also a sign of unity with Jesus and with each other. 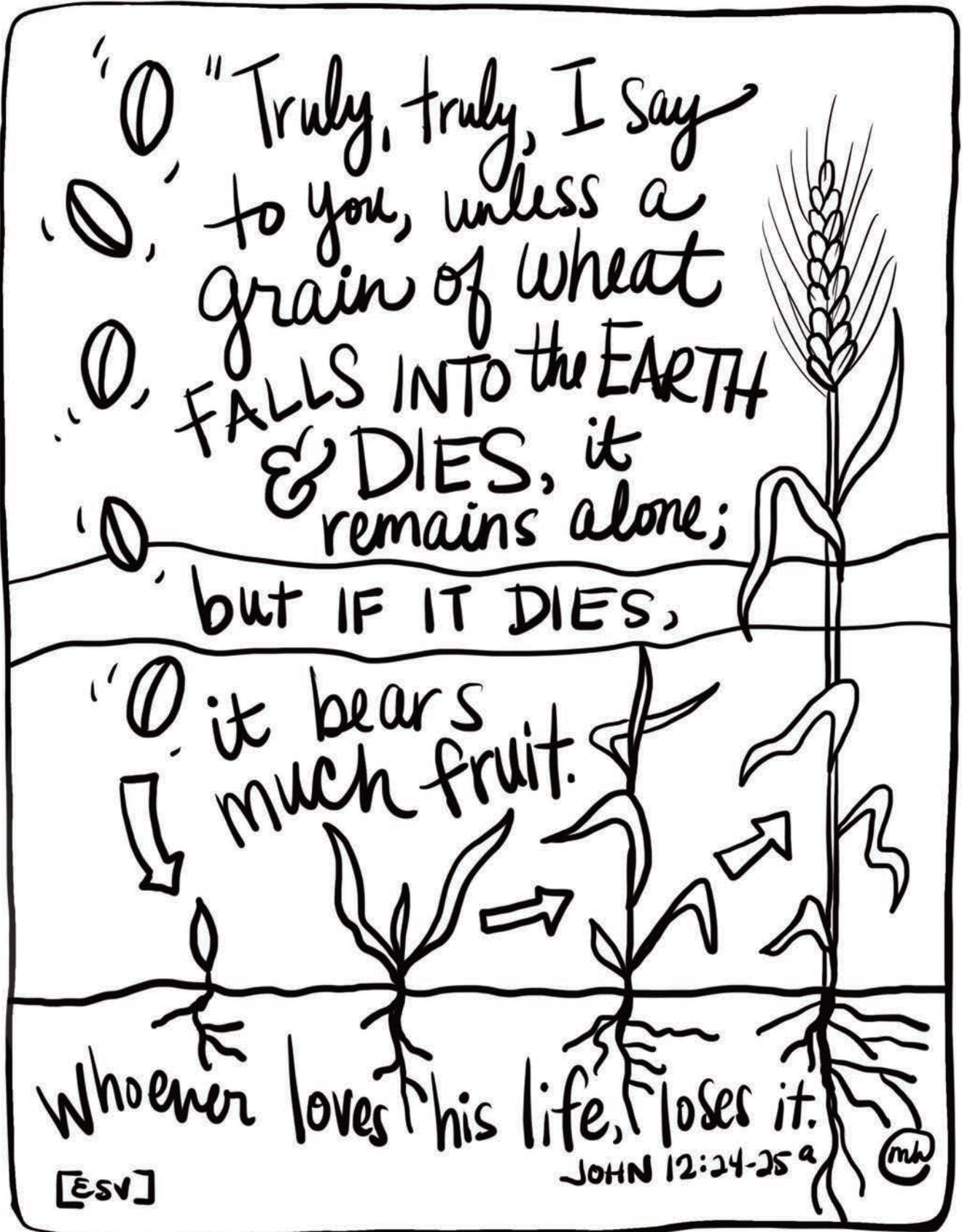

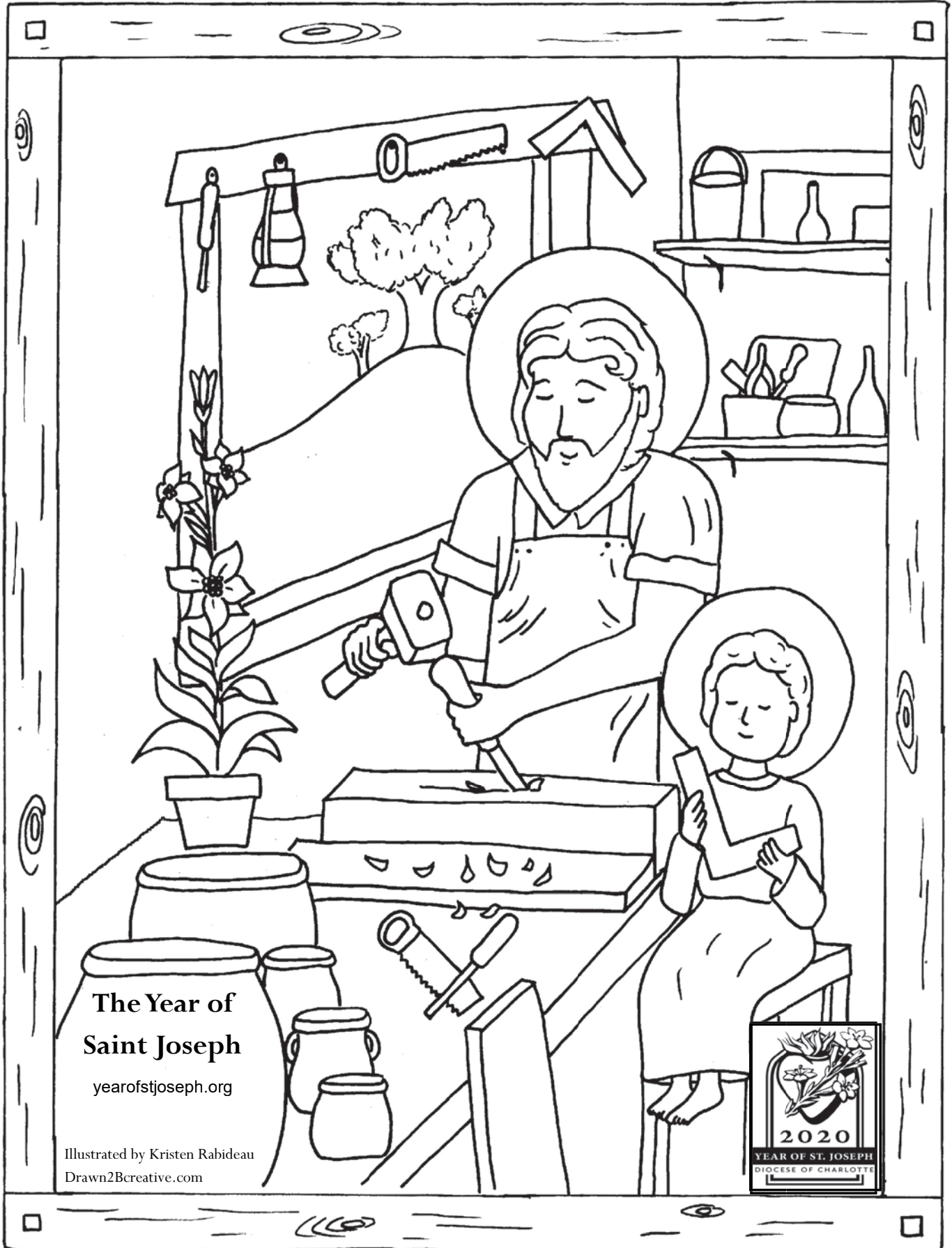
