





## Hope

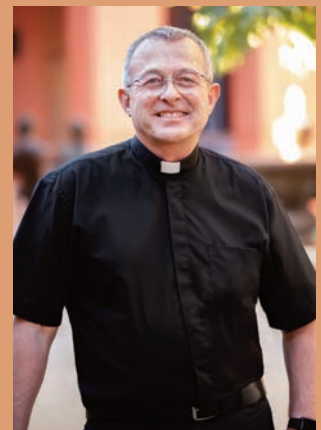
- When I consider the selfless and extraordinary efforts of the medical community this last year...

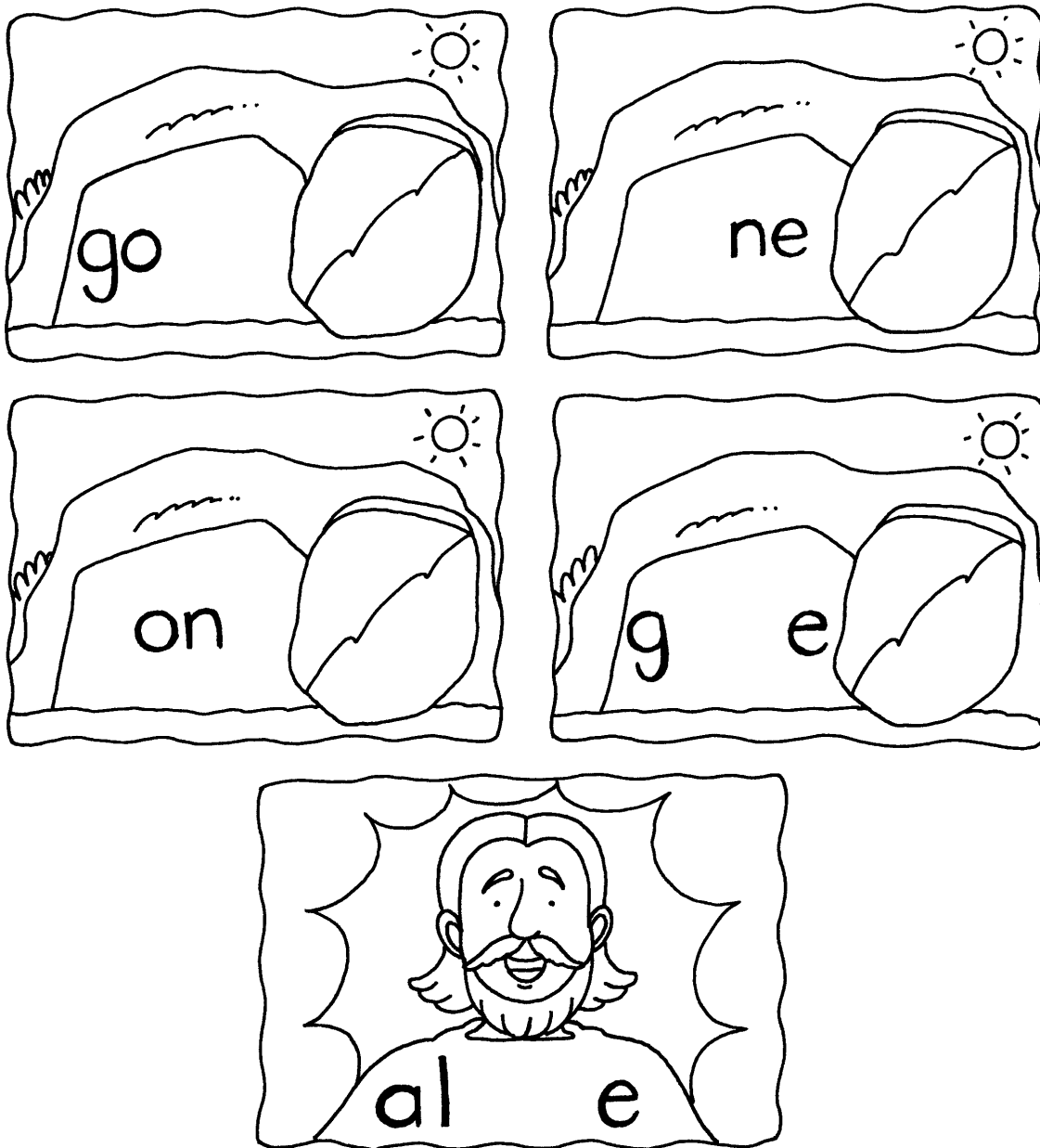
