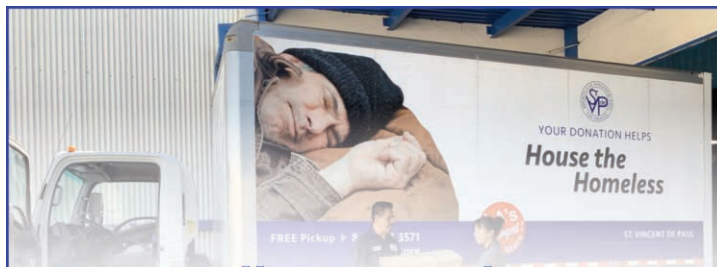

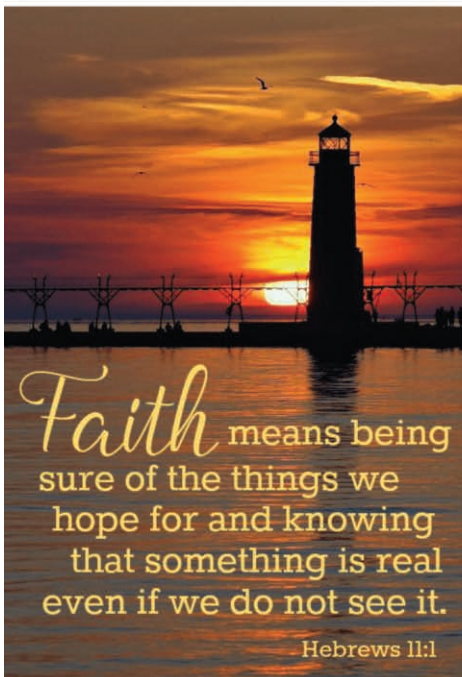

We Are Witnesses

Dear friends on the journey,

When I was a little girl, my grandmother gifted me with several Madame Alexander collectible dolls, the ones that represented different countries, with porcelain heads, perfectly coiffed hair, and beautifully stitched dresses. They looked so lovely on a shelf in my bedroom but were just too fragile and special that I could not bring myself to play with them or share with my friends. The dolls I did play with and share with playdates were on the floor with messy hair, mismatched clothes, smudged with peanut butter and jelly, well-traveled and loved with gusto.

Our faith can be like porcelain dolls when we wrap it nicely, put it on a shelf untouched, and occasionally admired in passing. However, today's readings remind us we are called to live our faith otherwise. We are to embrace our faith, embody it, share it and be witnesses to it.

To this point, Jesus has lived, ministered, preached, healed, suffered, died, and risen from the dead. One might think that is enough but Jesus' earthly work is not quite finished. Post Easter Sunday he knows the disciples are scared and worried about what to do next and need him a little bit longer. So, until his ascension, Jesus will spend time with the disciples, breaking bread, helping them understand scripture, bolstering their confidence, and preparing them for their new mission ... to go out and spread the Good News, to tell others about a life with Jesus.

Anything Jesus commands of the disciples in the gospels is our command also. So today we are reminded of our call to the mission of sharing the Good News. But what are we in fact sharing and how do we do it? Are we sharing that to have faith one must be pristine in all ways, have our act together, always doing and saying the right things? Not at all.

We are sharing our lived experience that in the messiness of our lives, in our often-well-intentioned stumbles and failures, in our choosing to put worldliness ahead of our relationship with God, we are still loved by God. We are sharing that every day we rise in the morning intending to do our best and, in moments of failing, we are forgiven by God who gets us so the next day we can arise again. We are sharing that the Good Friday moments of our lives are always endured because of Easter Sunday hope. We are sharing that despite the anxiety of the unknown, we trust God. We are sharing that God's peace, mercy and love is for everyone.

We can share the Good News with our words but to do so with our very lives is far more effective ... actions speak louder than words, right? Others will know us as disciples when they watch *how* we talk to the grocery checker, drive on the road, speak about others, forgive wrongdoings, and prioritize our relationship with God over all else.

At baptism, we were gifted faith, one that was not to be shelved and kept to ourselves. Rather a faith, a lifelong relationship with God, that we carry with us every day, wrestle with, hug tightly, learn, nurture, share with our friends and sometimes enjoy with a little peanut butter and jelly.

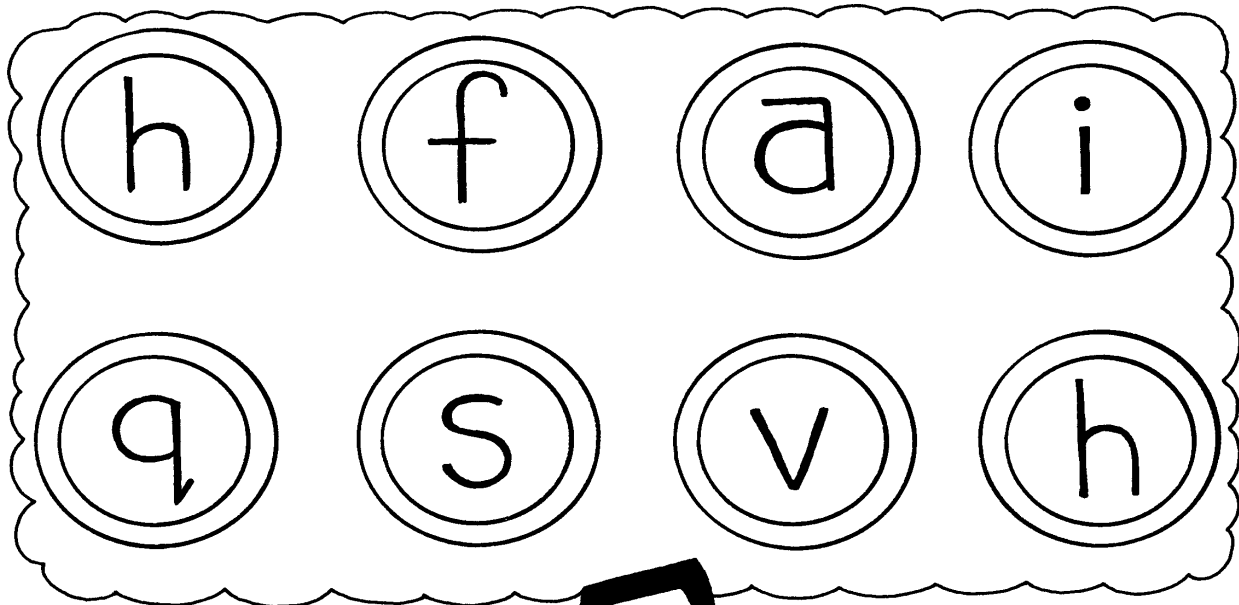

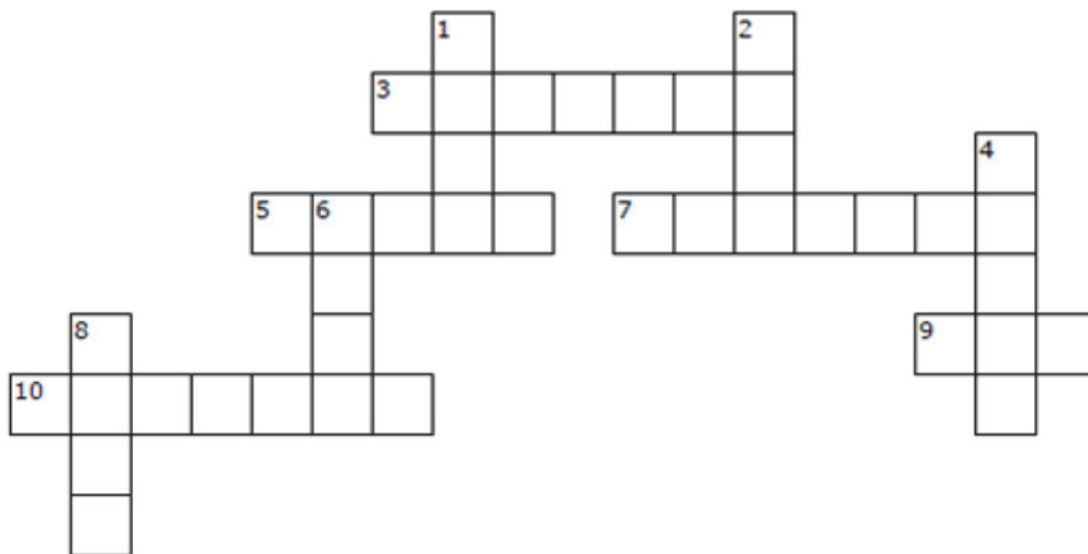
