Discipleship

Dear Faith Family,

"Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations."

It is something we have heard so many times. I don't know about you, but when the things I've heard a million times start to make sense, it is quite liberating.

This is Christ's call to us. As Christian people, we can't really call ourselves Christians unless we heed this great commission. This was spoken by Christ, not just for the 11 disciples going to the mountain, but rather, this is the instruction for all of those who choose to follow Christ.

Sounds scary, right? What if we don't have scripture memorized properly? What if we haven't opened a catechism in a decade? What if we have trouble wanting to go to Mass? These may sound like prerequisites to go spread the Word, but they aren't. This Gospel passage never mentions that you have to be perfect to let others know who God is. We must remember that no one becomes perfect, except through grace, which is given to us, not earned. The Apostles weren't perfect; you don't have to be either.

So how do we make disciples of all nations? I think the first and most important step is to stick to what/who you know. Father Patrick always shows his wisdom when he mentions that all nations may just mean Camarillo for some of us.

Whether it's a misquote or not, we frequently quote St. Francis of Assisi's "Preach the Gospel at all times, use words if necessary." While it is indeed true that we must set an example of HOW to live like a Christian with our actions, I would also argue that now might be the necessary time to use words as well. At this point, people also need to hear that God loves them.

During this tough year, I think plenty of people will admit it has taken a strain on their mental health, myself included. Actions can help others see who God is during this challenging time, but I can assure you that words help people see clearly that God loves them. Verbal affirmation is the perfect complement to beautiful actions.


So don't fret when you hear that we are called to make disciples of all nations. We will fail; we are indeed human.

But if we continue reading this Sunday's gospel, we recognize that Christ also says "... behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age." I don't think there is a more important message to share as we are seeking discipleship. There is no credentials needed; there is no prerequisite of perfection; this is not an exclusive club. Rather, God is with us, always and forever. We just need to help others to know that.

The Sacraments

The seven sacraments are essential to the Catholic way of life. They are blessed encounters with the risen Jesus. Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist are called the Sacraments of Initiation because they incorporate us into His saving death and resurrection. Baptism and Confirmation are not repeatable because they give us an "indelible mark" as members of the Body of Christ. Eucharist, the high point of our initiation, can be received daily, but at least on Sundays. The Eucharist nourishes and strengthens us to live as disciples of Jesus. It is also a sign of unity with Jesus and with each other.
