The Living Ark of the Covenant

Dear Faith Family,

I'm always amazed when I reflect upon our Blessed Mother. Upon reflection of this week's readings, there was no exception.

We've all heard the story of the Visitation. A pregnant Mary and her spouse travel through the hill country to the town of Judah to visit her cousin. Upon arrival, Elizabeth hears Mary's voice and the unborn John the Baptist leaps with joy.

At first glance, this is a very cute occurrence; not only is Elizabeth excited to see her family, but Baby John the Baptist can't help but to be excited to see his cousin as well. It is something we would see in a children's movie or in a book.

When we read between the lines though, it goes beyond just a cute occurrence; it is a recognition of Mary as the new Ark of the Covenant.

I'm sure many of us have seen "Raiders of the Lost Ark." If you are like me, the scene where the guy's face melts upon seeing the Ark is tattooed into your brain. Because of this, a lot of us would associate the Ark of the Covenant as some mythical case that was dangerous. But the Old Testament explains that essentially, the Ark contained God.

We believe that we have the body, blood, soul and divinity of Christ present in each tabernacle across the world. In fact, a lot of tabernacles have various themes within their structure that is similar to the Ark. Why am I mentioning this? Because Mary is the new Ark, the living tabernacle, who contained God. In fact, when John the Baptist leaps with joy, it is supposed to bring us back to the time when David would dance in front of the Ark. Scripture is not shy with the comparison.

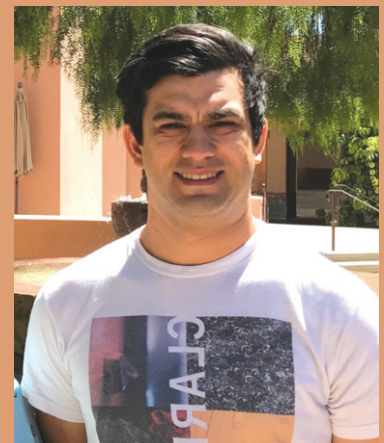
Obviously, we honor Mary in a unique way. Not as God, but as the one who has brought God to us. But sometimes we fall short in using the Blessed Mother as an *example* for us, especially as living tabernacles — as new Arks of the Covenant. Let us not be afraid to try to mimic our mom who was without sin, even when we fall short.

When we receive Christ in the Eucharist, we act as Mary and as the Ark. We are the ones containing Christ. We are the ones called to bring the actual King of Kings to the real world. We are the ones who are commissioned to help others understand that they are beloved by their creator. We need aid in this, and thank God we have Mary as an example of one that makes "disciples of all nations."


