## **Tere** (speaking from the cantor stand):

Welcome to Padre Serra, especially family and friends of our candidates for confirmation.

#### **PAUSE**

As we celebrate, we ask that everyone please maintain an atmosphere of reverence throughout the Mass. Please take a moment now to turn off or silence your cell phones. We also encourage you to stay prayerful throughout, remaining in the moment rather than creating a memory of it. At the bishop's request, please no photography or video of any kind during the liturgy. Thank you.

Tere steps down and cantor steps up. Cantor invites all to remain seated, and while the Confirmandi process in, to sing the "Litany of Saints".

### **Entrance Procession**

The procession begins with *candidates and sponsors*, two abreast in the east and two abreast in the west, in a mirrored pattern, moving north through the outer circle, turning south at the ambo, and entering the rows reserved for them (1-3).

The procession of *ministers and altar servers* enters the outer circle on the east side following the candidates. The procession goes around the *entire* outer circle to accommodate the Litany of Saints. Ministers reverence the altar and servers proceed to their places. The presider goes to the baptismal font.

we seek your protection through this water. Renew the living spring of your grace within us, and defend us from all ills of body and spirit, so we may approach you with hearts made clean

and receive your salvation.

We ask this through Jesus Christ our Lord.

## To Sung Gloria and Sprinkling

The assembly is sprinkled with holy water. The presider, accompanied by a server carrying the bowl, sprinkles the inner circle. The deacon, his wife and two other ministers, sprinkle the outer circle while the Gloria is sung.

life, who came upon the apostles at Pentecost and today is

given to you sacramentally in Confirmation?

Candidates: I do.

**Bishop:** Do you believe in the holy Catholic Church, the

communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting?

Candidates: I do.

**Bishop:** This is our faith. This is the faith of the Church. We are

proud to profess it in Christ Jesus our Lord.

All: Amen.

## Laying on of Hands

The candidates remain standing in their places. Presider goes to the top step, south side of the altar, facing north. He faces the people and says:

**Bishop:** My dear friends,

in baptism God our Father gave the new birth of eternal life to

his chosen sons and daughters.

We pray to our Father

that he will pour out the Holy Spirit

to strengthen his sons and daughters with his gifts

and anoint them to be more like Jesus Christ,

the Son of God.

All pray in silence for a short time. Presider extends his hands over all of them at once, as a group.

**Bishop:** All-powerful God, Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,

by water and the Holy Spirit

you freed your sons and daughters from sin

and gave them new life.

Send your Holy Spirit upon them

to be their Helper and Guide.

Give them the spirit of wisdom and understanding,

the spirit of right judgment and courage,

the spirit of knowledge and reverence.

Fill them with the spirit of wonder and awe in your presence.

We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.

(Tere Delgado will instruct the peer ushers to have rows 2 and 3 be seated at this time while row 1 remains standing.)

## **Anointing with Chrism**


Bishop Suavek moves to top altar step facing east. Fr. Patrick joins him there. Server brings the chrism to FP. The candidates stand, one row at a time, with their sponsors. The candidates approach the presider two abreast. They stand on the middle step facing the presider. Their sponsors are on the first step, with their right hand on the candidate's shoulder. The candidates are wearing name tags with their confirmation names in large print for the presider to read easily. The presider anoints the candidates, alternating between the two abreast, who then return to their seats (see diagram below) without waiting for their "partner". The newly confirmed sit as soon as they return to their places, not waiting for their row to be complete. Once all the candidates on the EAST side are confirmed, the presider moves to the WEST side and confirms those candidates in the same way.

**Bishop:** N., be sealed with the Gift of the Holy Spirit.

Newly Confirmed: Amen.

**Bishop:** Peace be with you.

Newly Confirmed: And with your spirit.

When the presider turns to process out, the Deacon will join him and place the candle in its stand near the baptismal font.
