Introductory Rites

Reverencing the altar at the end of the entrance procession, the presider goes to the blessed water. Deacon(s) will assist with the sprinkling rite.

Introduction to the Liturgy of the Day

And may we rejoice with all our sisters and brothers
who have been baptized in this same living water.
We ask this through Christ our Lord.

To Sung Gloria & Sprinkling Rite

The presider, accompanied by a server carrying the bowl, sprinkles the inner circle. The deacon and his wife and two other ministers, sprinkle the outer circle while the Gloria is sung.
