



## Summer Plans with God

Dear Parishioners,

With summer and our vacations almost upon us, I thought I'd take a moment to give you some encouragement to make your summer time special and close to God!

It's so important to bring a spirit of deep gratitude to God with you on vacation. So, before you travel, I encourage you to visit [masstimes.org](http://masstimes.org), where you can enter almost any place you will travel, even outside the U.S. You'll get a google map with markers of the local Catholic churches and their times for Masses and confessions throughout the week, as well as a link to their webpages, if they have any. There are also some Mass-time apps for you to investigate. So plan some time on your Sunday mornings for Mass.

If you'll be visiting with friends or family in far-off places, let them know that worshipping God on Sunday morning is a priority. Most will make an effort to accommodate you. Your expressing this interest is a form of evangelizing them – proclaiming the powerful place God has in your life.

If you can, keep the bulletins from the churches you visit and share them with me when you return. I learn all kinds of things from reviewing other parishes' activities in their bulletins.

By the way, many cruises have Catholic chaplains offering Mass onboard.

On a different note, I encourage you to get a paperback Bible and put it in the trunk of your car, or download the Bible to your iPhone, perhaps the New American Bible, Revised Edition, which has an app for only \$2.99. Put a post-it note at Psalm 104, to pray when you're in the mountains or at the ocean – It's a beautiful hymn of praise for all of God's creation. Another would be Psalm 66, especially verses 6-14, when at the ocean or in a place where farmers bring forth food from the earth. If you're ever in a place where you can see the Milky Way, have Psalm 8 close to hand and recount the glory of God's heavens. Perhaps, in a place of wild beauty, you'll want to simply reread the first chapter of the Bible, Genesis 1, on the creation of the world. A really special thing to do, in a place of wild beauty, with the spouse you love passionately, is to read the Song of Solomon together. The NABRE puts a "W" where the woman is to read, and an "M" where the man is supposed to read. There are some comical moments, comparing one's wife to a mare, or one's husband to an apple tree, but there are even more expressions that are beautiful. If flying gets to you, Psalm 91 is a lovely prayer for God's calming assistance.

If you're interested in a book to share with your small children on a road trip, take a look at *Does God Know How to Tie Shoes*, by Nancy White Carlstrom.

If you're going to spend time with family and friends, consider avoiding politics for a while longer. Everyone's feeling a bit fragile, and it's so easy to spoil a good time with talk on divisive issues. Give yourself permission to kindly, *kindly*, tell your kin that you'd rather talk about something else.

I hope you have the most wonderful journeys. It might be nice, though, to give yourself some time to really *rest*. God rested at the end of Creation. Leave some time for that in whatever vacation time you have.

Remember, if you don't have any vacation time coming, that if you run down to Point Mugu with a beach chair and a sandwich and whatever else you want to snack on, you can give yourself a mini-vacation at a place of spectacular beauty. We are *so* lucky to live where we do!

As your father, I need to remind you to put on your sunscreen and have *amazing* adventures.

### Summer Water Safety

Drowning is the second leading cause of death for people ages 5-24. Parents should be mindful of safety habits while at the pool, beach or lake: undistracted supervision, CPR and first aid training, and understand dangers of pool drains, currents, life jackets. Children should also be taught safe habits: never go in the water if they don't know how to swim, swim only with others and with a lifeguard present, and other potential dangers like rough play, currents, and diving.



# St. Junipero Serra Feast Day July 1

Today we celebrate the feast of our patron, St. Junipero Serra. Born on Spain's island of Mallorca on November 24, 1713, he entered the Franciscan Order and until he was 35, spent most of his time in the classroom as a student of theology and then as a professor. He gave it all up to do missionary work in South America, desiring to evangelize in the New World.

Arriving by ship at Vera Cruz, Mexico, he and a companion walked the 250 miles to Mexico City. On the way Junipero's left leg became infected by an insect bite and would remain a cross to bear for the rest of his life. For 18 years, he worked in central Mexico and in the Baja Peninsula, traveling thousands of miles to preach, teach, and administer the sacraments.

In 1769, Fr. Serra joined Captain Portola's expedition to Alta California to continue exploration, bring Christianity to the north and establish missions. July 1 is the day he crossed into Alta California on his way to found Mission San Diego. The second mission was San Carlos Borromeo in Monterey but, in 1771, it was moved to Carmel and served as his headquarters, where he oversaw the planning, construction and staffing of each mission.

In his 14 years in California, Fr. Serra established 9 missions, including our own Mission San Buenaventura to serve the spiritual needs of the Chumash people. Another 12 missions were founded along the El Camino Real after his death. Junipero's missionary life was a long battle with pain, cold and hunger, with unsympathetic military commanders and often with potential deadly situations. Through it all his unquenchable zeal was fed by prayer each night, often from midnight till dawn. Traversing the coast of California, he baptized over 6,000 people and confirmed 5,000. On August 28, 1784, at the age of 70 Father Junipero Serra died at Mission San Carlos Borromeo and was buried there the next day under the sanctuary floor.

The word that best describes Junipero is *zeal*. It was a spirit that came from his deep prayer and dauntless will. "Always forward, never back" was his motto. Just as was the case with Serra, who was all about the indigenous people, parishes aren't about buildings. They are about people, and if we're going to build anything, let it be the reign of God in our midst. Who we are and what we do are the direct results of the labors of a saint, our own Junipero Serra. Our efforts are also aimed at helping each and every one of us to encounter Jesus, become His disciples, and ultimately become saints ourselves.
