Follow Me

Dear friends on the journey,

They left everything and followed him!

Our gospel this weekend is Peter, James and John's call to follow Jesus into ministry and a new life. To do so required giving up their former life, jobs, security, their very livelihood. We certainly know what happens next for all of them.

Today Jesus invites us to follow him too. Really, every day is an invitation to follow him. Like the apostles some of us may actually be called in a radical way to leave the material possessions and the comforts of our life to follow Jesus to distant lands and peoples. In reality most of us are called right where we are – in our homes, neighborhoods, jobs – to follow Jesus, to daily conversion, to bring his Good News to others, and to live in unity with the Trinity. But to do so requires leaving something behind, some sacrifice.



We may need to leave behind past hurts, grudges, anger, repetitive sins, stubbornness, pride, addiction, self-reliance, guilt, shame, greed, excess, whatever it is that hardens our heart and binds us so tightly that we have no room to experience God's love, for Jesus' call to love God and others fully and for the Holy Spirit to speak into our hearts and invite us to something greater than ourselves.

Oh this isn't easy! It's not meant to be but Jesus promises to always be with us. He doesn't call us then turn his back, hoping we'll catch up. I just love this stained glass image of Jesus in our chapel. It can mean different things at different times. But today it reminds me that when Jesus calls us, he stretches out his hands and promises to be the way, the truth and light along the way.

This week let's do some reflection on our call to follow Jesus and ask ourselves: First do I even want to accept the call? What might it even look like? What do I need to release to follow Jesus more fully? Then dream of the possibilities this freedom and openness can bring.
