Dear friends on the journey,

As I write this, I am preparing to visit the Holy Land. On May 13, Fr. Patrick and 41 parishioners departed for a weeklong journey, visiting the holiest of places, the land where Jesus was born, lived, died and resurrected. I'm wondering what it will be like to see, feel, taste, and smell all of Israel. Will we encounter Jesus there like the people of his time did?




