Our Future Youth Space

Dear Faith Family,

As you may know, we have great plans for the future of our parish campus. In our vision, we have plans to build both a new youth center and an office for music and liturgy. It is quite a big dream, but I am confident that with your help, we can achieve it.

As the person who facilitates both our High School Confirmation session and our weekly Youth Group, I can tell you that there is definitely a need for a dedicated space for our youth and young adults at the parish.

It is not uncommon for each year of our Confirmation process to have 130-140 teens and leaders in attendance. Before each session, all people involved in the program gather for lunch in the San Juan Capistrano rooms. These rooms are unable to fit the number of people that we have involved in the process. Because of the lack of space, we potentially miss out on various evangelistic opportunities and it adds an obstacle for an opportunity for community building for those who need it.

A dedicated youth space is also desired so we can create a more effective "home away from home" for our teens and young adults. Many of our teens love to spend time at their parish, but they find it difficult because the only dedicated space is quite small. There are times where we have dozens of people cramming into a leisure space that can comfortably fit 4-6 people.

To create a comfortable space for the youth and young adults of the parish would only increase the opportunities for our young people to know God and to be disciples.

Of course, none of this can happen without the help from all of you. Because of this, I want to invite you to contribute in any way that you can. Through *Called to Renew* we are given an opportunity to contribute to this necessary cause.

Thank you so much for your willingness to contribute and I am looking forward to experiencing this great renewal with all of you!


