

Bring a can for the food pantry and stay after for refreshments in the courtyard.



What is a Scrutiny Rite?

Lent is the final stage of formation for the Elect who will celebrate the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and First Communion at the upcoming Easter Vigil. This year we have five young Elect who will celebrate a special rite called a Scrutiny on March 31 at the 11:00 am Mass in preparation for the sacraments. A Scrutiny is a profound prayer of healing and strengthening. It helps the Elect examine their lives to see where they may need to repent and reform. It is also meant to reveal and strengthen all that is strong and good in the Elect. It is not only the Elect who benefit from the Scrutiny. As we pray for them we recognize our own sinfulness and need for God's healing love, and we pray that God will strengthen us as well.
