Our Source and Summit

Dear Parish Family,

Just recently I discovered that the root words of Companion in Latin, *cum* which means with and *panis* which means bread. So 'companion' literally means someone whom I share bread with. Wow! This made me reflect on the fact that meals are so fundamentally important to us. Not only for our body's nourishment but also as rewards, celebrations! It's been my personal experience that the best way to enjoy a great meal is always in the company of others. Those we usually sit



with to share a meal, we call our family, our friends, we have a bond, a relationship. When we invite people to our table we share more than just food, we welcome in others, we share trust, friendship and love. We feel honored to be part of special someone's table, or that they are joining us at ours. When our meal is over, not only are our bellies full but our heart and spirit too!

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. The Eucharist is the meal that we share in the Lord's memory and at his command. By inviting us to partake of the sacred food of the Eucharist, Jesus makes us his companions and friends. And in doing so we ought to become companions and friends to one another.

This past year, with the pandemic, especially those early months when we experienced a complete shutdown, it was challenging to say the least. We were deprived of so many things, especially of the opportunity to gather as a community and to receive Jesus in the Eucharist. During this time, my soul cried out for the day we could once again receive Jesus in the Eucharist, to be nourished, though I did do spiritual communions and continued my prayer life that fills my spirit. I often think of it as "snacks for the soul"; it is meant to sustain you. While the Eucharist is the "main dish" and the true nourishment, strength for the journey. This is one of the silver linings coronavirus brought to my life; never again to take for granted the gift of being able to come to the table of the Lord.

We need Christ, this is obvious! But we also need each other. To be a Christian means to be a community of believers. The first Christians supported and forgave one another, they shared their possessions and looked out for each other's needs. Sharing creates a bond that leads us to loving and serving one another.

This past May we welcomed 100 children to the table of the Lord. May they continue to be nourished all the days of their lives. I am so grateful we can once again gather as a community, especially for the incredible gift of his Real Presence in the Eucharist.


