





Strength Through Weakness

Dear friends on the journey,

In today's second reading from 2 Corinthians, God tells Paul that "my grace is sufficient for you, for power is made perfect in weakness." Paul was experiencing difficulties with his audience. Rather than just alleviate the trials, God reminded Paul that he must rely on God's grace for strength.

Since before March 2020, our world has been weakened by a virus that has spread across nations and peoples with no concern for its devastating effects, on those who died, those who recovered with and without long-term effects, their loved ones, and many of us who could only watch and pray. Home projects, Netflix, distance working and learning, and more kept us busy but very quickly we realized none of it was sustainable without each other. We became weak without connection to family and friends so we began to connect through technology and social media like never before.

During this time, our parish realized a longtime dream to livestream Sunday liturgy. Never before had I felt so connected with my parish family, despite the physical distance. Almost immediately our ministries moved online in order to continue formation, support, prayer and fellowship for hundreds of people each week:






