




The Apostles' Creed





What does a concert have to do with church?

Dear Friends,

The psalms are the prayer book of the Church. At the Liturgy of the Hours (Morning, Daytime, Evening and Night Prayer) the psalms form the vast majority of all that ordained clergy and consecrated religious are expected to pray daily for life. Lay people are encouraged but not required to do so. Many of you pray Morning Prayer together before Daily Mass. And of course, we pray/sing the Responsorial Psalm after the first reading at every Mass, particularly on Sundays and Holy Days.

Probably the most frequent command in the psalms is "Praise the Lord!" Here is the text of Psalm 150, the last of the psalter:

Hallelujah! Praise God in his holy sanctuary; give praise in the mighty dome of heaven. Give praise for his mighty deeds, praise him for his great majesty. Give praise with blasts upon the horn, praise him with harp and lyre. Give praise with tambourines and dance, praise him with strings and pipes. Give praise with crashing cymbals, praise him with sounding cymbals. Let everything that has breath give praise to the LORD! Hallelujah!

My friend Alexander Tseitlin and I intend to obey this command at a recital, here at Padre Serra (www.padreserra.org/summerconcert), on July 25 at 5:30 pm. Alex will cover the "strings" (violin and viola) and I'll substitute piano for "harp and lyre." You'll hear music by Bach, Schubert, Rachmaninoff and Gershwin. Come early and bring a picnic to enjoy *al fresco* in the courtyard before the concert. The concert won't be a stuffy affair at all. We will talk to you in between playing.

Alex (alexandertseitlin.com/about) is the artistic director of the Conejo Valley Youth Orchestras, a gifted teacher, a marvelous musician and a delightful human being. He and I have put together a light program, perfect for a Sunday afternoon, to celebrate and praise God for easing of pandemic restrictions and countless other blessings. 
