





## The Apostles' Creed



## **Make Room for Holy Interruptions**

Dear Parish Family,

As I read and meditated over the readings of this weekend, I must admit I had to re-read them several times. I have heard these readings before, yet this time I felt like I was hearing them again for the very first time, and the message was so new. In our Gospel, Mark tells us about the apostles who had returned from their mission and shared with Jesus all that they had done. Jesus, knowing they must have been exhausted, encouraged them to "Come away to a deserted place and rest." What a wonderful request — go take a break, get some rest. Jesus knew the importance of rest; we must recharge our bodies and spirits, that we can once again return to our mission. However, when they reached their destination, they were unable to rest. The people were waiting for them; there was not time even to eat! Jesus could have sent them away but he doesn't. He, along with his exhausted apostles, continues to teach, heal and feed the people. What happened to their plans to rest?

How often we make plans and they get interrupted. This reminded me of a story I read about a newly ordained priest, who at his first parish assignment was so excited to get started with all his plans to bring a better understanding of the Word of God to his parishioners. He would teach a group of parishioners who would then in turn teach others and so on. On the first day, when he was to teach, the cook came to him, so upset. The toilet of the sacristy had overflowed. Being that he was a handy guy, he took the time to fix it, which took up his day. On the next day, as he was heading to his gathering, a group of young children were distraught over the loss of their pet — what should they do? The young priest knew it was important to help the children, as this was their first encounter with death, and he accompanied them as they buried the pet in the backyard and prayed with them for comfort. On another day, he had one of his parishioners come by for a visit who asked Father to write a letter of recommendation for a job for her grandson, who was having a hard time finding a job.

The young priest did eventually have the time to begin his study group, even with all those interruptions. He shared that he thought the study group he was so eager to get started would make a huge change and impact to his parish community. However, he discovered that the bigger impact was made in what he now calls "holy interruptions." Because with every interruption he had the opportunity to share the Love of God with them. The opportunity to give of himself, just like Our God is always giving himself to us. The direct encounters with the people, that made the Word of God come to life.

None of the tasks were those of priestly responsibilities. These are things that any one of us can do: fix or repair something that is broken, be physically present/accompany others in their grief or joy, write a letter, just to name

a few. I think that perhaps God is trying to get our attention through the interruptions and the distractions of our ordinary day. These are opportunities to love others and put into action God's word. Let's make room for holy interruptions, as we go about our plans.


