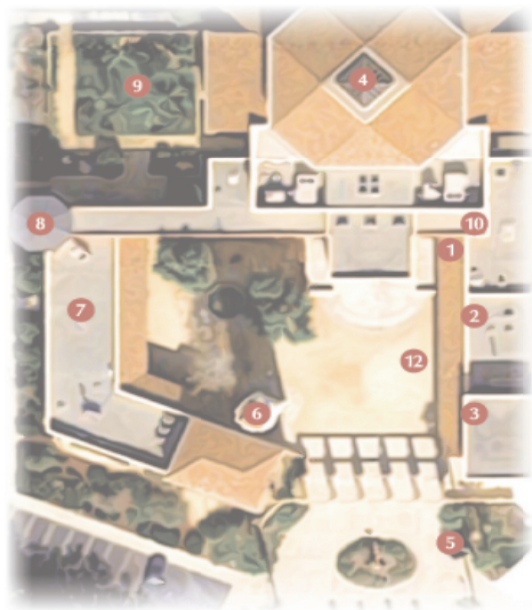

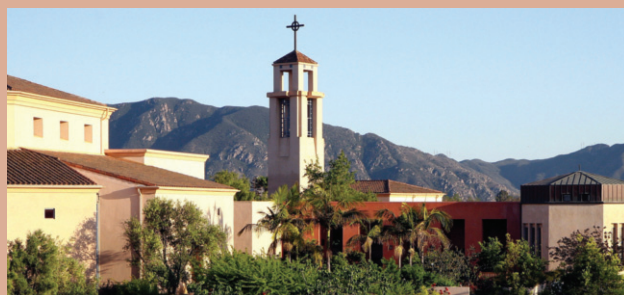

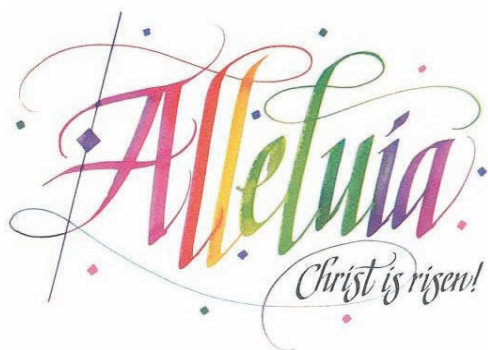
Women's Ministry New Faith Sharing Group Monday, April 17 7:00-8:30pm

Rebirth at Easter

Happy Easter! I'm hoping that this Easter is a day of joy for you, with family and friend time to celebrate our faith. Even more, I'm praying that just as Easter morning brought new life to Jesus, that it might be the starting point for new life for all of us. I have a few different starting points for you to consider.

New life in the midst of political tumult: What do we do when many people speak very loudly, and with complete confidence, making contradictory points? I encourage you to root yourself in the teachings of Jesus. Our primary vision can be determined by a political party, or by our identification with Jesus. If we put Jesus first, we find that we have to step back from a naïve acceptance of either Democrat or Republican positions. I encourage you this Easter to re-root yourself in the Lord, the real answer to the world's problems. There is a price to pay for fidelity, but the gain is a much better world for us and our children.



New life in our relationships: All of our serious relationships can use an occasional reboot. The exuberant passion of our early years can dim and be replaced by dull sameness and slogging endurance. The enjoyment of our friends can so easily grow cool. Why settle for that? Taking Jesus seriously we are constantly encouraged to keep working on our relationships, the only way that any of them will work. In particular, we are called to selflessness, the foundation of the only kinds of relationships that work to bring mutual happiness. We're supported by the Lord with the assistance to accomplish it (we call that "grace").

New life at work: Is our job only a means to an end, paying the bills and keeping a roof over our heads and food on the table? Jesus actually had a vision of building a Kingdom where everyone's labor worked together to create a just and caring society. Can the hope implicit in the resurrection be the starting point for relooking at our jobs and their value to the greater good? Yes, and it can renew the way we value all of our efforts.

New life in parenting: What a challenge it is to parent in the current American milieu! Technology, soccer, AP courses, single parent households, two working parent households, exhaustion! How could we possibly hope to accomplish this without spiritual uplift and encouragement to be our very best and most generous selves? Make Jesus' teachings and vision a part of your care for your children.

My invitation to you this Easter is simply to take advantage of everything that Jesus wants for you, and from you. He's willing to work with you to accomplish this. I encourage you to make this the foundation for what happens next in your life.

God bless you in everything!

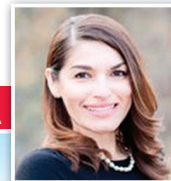
