The Easter Vigil: A Celebration of New Life Saturday, April 15 ~ 7:30-10:00pm

Why wait for Easter morning? Come celebrate the resurrection of Jesus as it happened, between the darkness of the cross and the dazzling morning light at the empty tomb. The Easter Vigil starts at dusk and continues into the night. A bonfire blazes, candles are lit, stories of salvation are proclaimed, alleluias and glorias resound, and the baptismal pool is finally put to use when our Elect are immersed into the waters of Baptism and anointed with chrism.

The richness of the Easter Vigil liturgy with its emphasis on baptism, on dying to sin and rising to new life, on remembering how God has led us to salvation through Jesus Christ, and on the glory and wonder of darkness being transformed by the light of Jesus' presence – all this contributes to a liturgical celebration that you won't soon forget. And there's plenty of room to park!




Community Reconciliation Service Wednesday, April 5 7:00pm, Church

Protecting God's Children

What do parishioner volunteers Lisa Barra, Suzy Maraboto, Jackie Perrin and Linda Smith along with parish staff Brett Becker, Eve Collier, Tere Delgado, Deacon Neil Kingsley, Anne McMahon and myself have in common? We are all members of the Safeguard the Children committee. This committee cares for a very specific aspect of parish life. We act to ensure compliance with a prescribed formula of activities set forth by the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops and the Archdiocese of Los Angeles proven to keep the vulnerable safe from abuse and specifically sexual abuse.

At Padre Serra, we are committed to protecting God's children. All adults who work with or around children must attend Virtus awareness training. Additionally, adults who supervise children must be live-scan fingerprinted by the Archdiocese of Los Angeles. We encourage all adults in our community to attend Virtus to stay informed about child safety.

Virtus - Protecting God's Children Awareness Training – is a free, three-hour workshop that helps clergy, staff, volunteers, parents, grandparents and neighbors to understand the facts and myths about child sexual abuse; how perpetrators operate; and how caring adults can take five important steps to keep children safe.

For children and teens we teach the Touching Safety Program. Required by the Archdiocese of Los Angeles for children enrolled in school or parish programs, Touching Safety is a vehicle through which parents, teachers, leaders and youth ministers give children and young people the tools they need to protect themselves from those who might harm them. Our Faith Formation team presents this material to help children identify unsafe situations, say stop and tell a trusted adult. We created a special children's bulletin for this month that covers these topics. Please take one for family discussion; available in church.

Our Safeguard the Children committee conducts an annual campus assessment and reviews ministry and administrative processes to make sure we are doing all we can to keep everyone safe and protected at church. It takes all of us watching, particularly on Sundays when more crowded. Parents, always escort children everywhere, especially to restrooms and keep an eye on them at all times. We cannot presume because we are at church that our kids may have more freedom here than at a public park. How helpful and beautiful that we all keep a caring eye on everyone's kids.

Our parish is richly blessed by children on our campus every day of the week. Whether its choir, altar serving, Faith Formation, summer camp, Stay and Play, Little Church, scouts, youth ministry, family events and all the other activities we provide for our children we, staff and volunteers, make their safety a top priority and count on the whole parish to stay vigilant.

This weekend marks the start of Child Protection Month, observed nationally every April. Today, members of the

Safeguard the Children committee are in the courtyard to answer questions, share information and take notes about concerns. Please stop by and say 'hello and thank you' to this 'behind the scenes' and important group that seeks to keep Padre Serra a wonderful place for your children.


