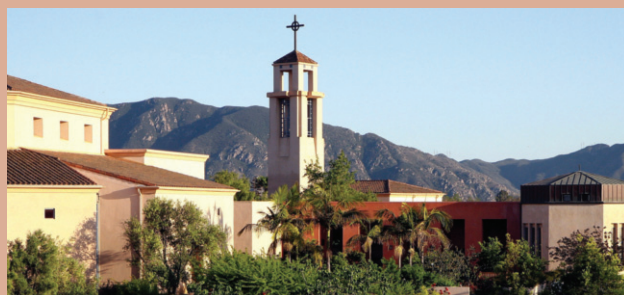

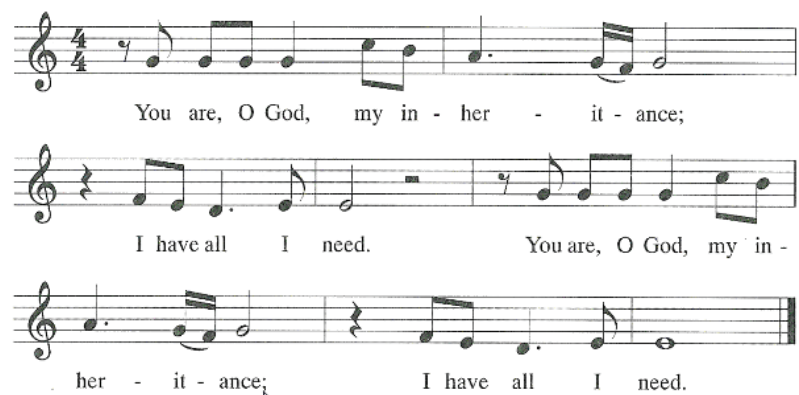

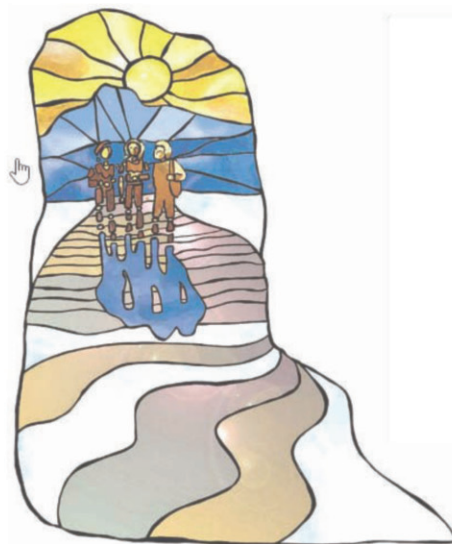

Today's Gospel reminds us that we are all on a journey...

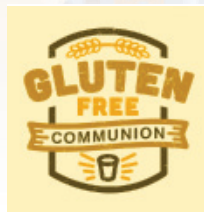

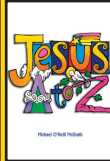
