



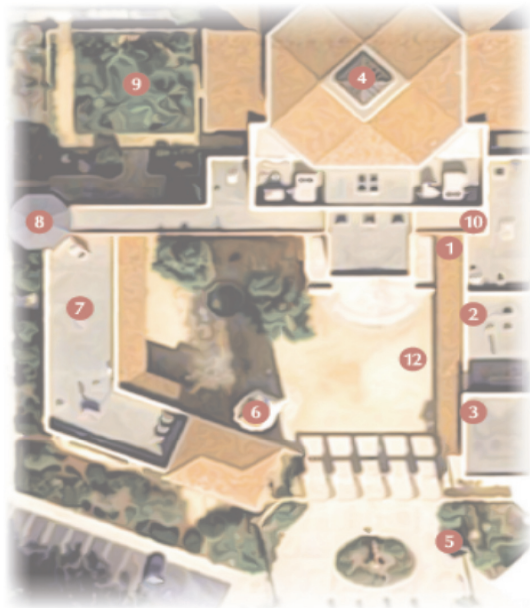

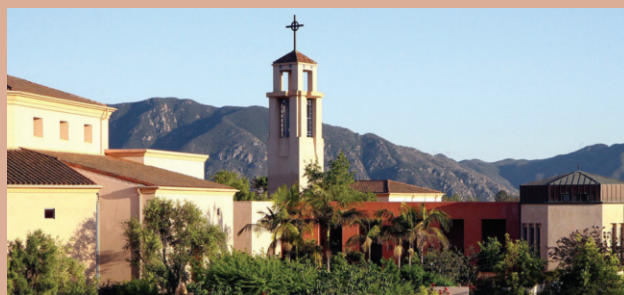

The Easter Vigil: A Celebration of New Life Saturday, April 15 ~ 7:30-10:00pm

Why wait for Easter morning? Come celebrate the resurrection of Jesus as it happened, between the darkness of the cross and the dazzling morning light at the empty tomb. The Easter Vigil starts at dusk and continues into the night. A bonfire blazes, candles are lit, stories of salvation are proclaimed, alleluias and glorias resound, and the baptismal pool is finally put to use when our Elect are immersed into the waters of Baptism and anointed with chrism.

The richness of the Easter Vigil liturgy with its emphasis on baptism, on dying to sin and rising to new life, on remembering how God has led us to salvation through Jesus Christ, and on the glory and wonder of darkness being transformed by the light of Jesus' presence – all this contributes to a liturgical celebration that you won't soon forget. And there's plenty of room to park!

Jesus on the Shore

Dear Faith Family,

We are counting down the days to the most powerful day of our Christian year! Easter and its celebrations are awaiting us and we are currently in the home stretch. Stay strong, Cadbury Eggs and Big Macs are just around the corner.

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus reveals Himself as Lord to the disciples. While we have many times in our lives where Christ reveals himself as Lord, we can take this for granted. While this may be a sign of comfort within our faith, which is not necessarily a bad thing, we should always look back on the days where there is no doubt that we have a loving God who died for our sins.

In the Gospel, the disciples attempt to fish, but nothing comes of it. At dawn, Christ is standing on the shore, awaiting his friends, but no one even recognizes that He is there. Even after Jesus talks to them, they do not realize that it is Christ talking to them. How many times in our lives do we not realize that Jesus is standing there, just waiting to be with us? How many times do we perceive the grace of God just to be a common coincidence on the shore?

This Lent, even if it was fruitful, there may have been times that we didn't even recognize Christ's presence. Even through our Lenten sacrifices and increased prayer, our human limitation can make us perceive the person on the shore to be just a normal person, not Christ.

The invitation in the Gospel is quite breathtaking: Jesus simply asks the disciples to cast a net. I like to think that the disciples cast the net as a last resort, willing to do whatever is asked of them, from anybody, with no reluctance and maybe a little bit of apathy and frustration. Sometimes during Lent, this is me. Giving up things and attempting a stronger spiritual life, just because it was asked, sometimes I do not realize who is asking.

My favorite part of this Gospel, though, is that after Christ's miracle of the fish, when they swam ashore, "none of the disciples dared to ask him, 'Who are you?' because they realized it was the Lord."

How many times has the Lord revealed His love to us? How many times have we recognized it? When we do recognize it, what do we do?

There is no doubt in my mind that the Son of God is calling for us constantly. But it's up to us to swim ashore and just be with Him. With no questions, no proclamations, just an understanding that we are there with our God and he is awaiting us on the shore.

My prayer for all of us during this last week of Lent is that we recognize Christ's presence in our lives and in others.

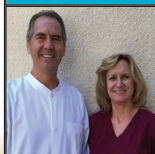
