I. OUR PARISH PROMISE

1. We will welcome you regardless of your situation in life, whether you are single, married, divorced or widowed, whatever the state of your marriage, including those in a mixed faith marriage, and those sharing a home without marriage. We will welcome you whether you are gay or lesbian, transgender or straight, an immigrant or a newcomer; whether you are fully or differently abled, healthy or sick, old or young, rich or poor. We will welcome you whether you are struggling with your faith or firm in your commitment. We will maintain an open door and an open heart to you and offer you a place to share in the life of the parish and grow in relationship with Jesus Christ.
2. We will “keep holy the Sabbath” by making well-prepared weekend Masses the single most important focal point of parish life. We will not conduct any Sunday business meetings.
3. We commit ourselves to providing all children a safe, affectionate environment with well-trained and vetted teachers and volunteers.
4. We will offer meaningful faith formation and retreat opportunities for everyone. We will also provide quality speakers and comfortable meeting places to help you encounter Jesus.
5. We are your ministers and companions. If you call us for help, with a question, or to ask for prayer, we will do everything possible to provide it for you.
6. We will provide opportunities for you to meet with social and spiritual groups.
7. We will help you find ways to serve the poor and suffering and coach you to help people in need.
8. When you give money to God for the support of the parish, we promise to be good stewards of the resources entrusted to us and responsibly care for the people, ministries, staff, facilities and our church, where we gather to celebrate and to mourn at the sacred milestones of our lives.

II. OUR HOUSEHOLD PROMISE
