





#### **Welcome to Together in Mission 2017**

It has been my honor to be a part of Padre Serra for the past four years. Each year more than 500 families have stepped forward in Together in Mission to share with parishes and schools in our diocese who struggle to stay afloat financially.

This year I am especially honored to introduce our guest speaker who will share her personal experience with Together in Mission. I am honored in the sense that our speaker is someone I have known for many years and who has a special place in my family's hearts. In past years I spoke of my children, both of whom are internationally adopted and both came to America speaking no English, just one of their challenges.

Our son, Christopher, was adopted from Nicaragua and from the moment he arrived in America he had struggle after struggle. For our whole family Christopher's situation seemed almost hopeless until the angel who is our speaker today came into our lives. Kathleen Delgado was the principal of Our Lady of the Valley Elementary School in Canoga Park and that is how we came to know her. Our son was in fourth grade in public school and each day he became more frustrated than the day before. By the time March rolled around we were all relieved that only three more months of struggle to endure in the public school remained. We had tried to get Chris in a Catholic school, but it was seemingly not possible. Christopher arrived in American in November and in March a miracle occurred when Mrs. Delgado learned of Christopher through another principal and even though her school struggled financially and had limited resources she called and said she was willing to accept Christopher at her school immediately and within a couple of days he was proudly wearing an OLV school uniform. It changed his life completely and Mrs. Delgado and her loyal, dedicated teachers gave Christopher the love and support that he needed. To this day Christopher has fond memories and gratitude for Mrs. Delgado and his teachers and classmates, many of whom he still has contact with. Not only did Christopher graduate 8th grade with Mrs. Delgado as his principal, but went on to graduate high school and now hopes to become a paramedic.

I was so pleased when a few years ago I saw that Our Lady of the Valley was getting support from Together in Mission. They deserved the help and put it to wonderful use. Clearly I am sure that it was part of God's plan that Mrs. Delgado's talents be shared with other schools in our diocese, and after more than a decade of keeping Our Lady of the Valley School afloat and a blessing to so many students, she moved on to be the Assistant Superintendent of Elementary Schools in our diocese.

We have heard from many Together in Mission speakers over the years who have shared their experiences, but I can guarantee this weekend's speaker will touch your hearts and share her experiences and challenges in a very meaningful way. She did not just witness from afar the benefits of Together in Mission, she lived and breathed them.

Our Together in Mission goal this year is \$107,600. To reach that goal we look forward to participation from even more people in our parish. I am confident after hearing today's speaker we all will be moved to participate and share our generosity and realize in a very personal way how important this program is.

Thank you, Kathy Delgado, and many blessings to all of you as you contemplate your participation.


