Dear friends on the journey,

Merry Christmas, Blessed Solemnity of Blessed Virgin Mary, the Mother of God, and Happy New Year!

The first of January ushers in a new year, a fresh beginning, and a time when we resolve to improve ourselves. Typically, these resolutions are focused on improving our body, our physical well-being through new diet and exercise routines, or perhaps we desire to expand our minds by trying a new hobby, reading more, or expanding our knowledge base. 


