My Sabbatical

The Archdiocese encourages priests to take a sabbatical every seven years. I have been eligible since I came to Padre Serra Parish, but have waited till the beginning of my seventh year here. My work at the seminary has decreased a lot this last semester, giving me some freedom on that side. The parish is in a good place, with an excellent pastoral team and staff (about whom I don't brag enough). It's a good time for me to participate in some time of renewal. So ... my plans:

- (1) Over the course of this last year, for the first time, but repeatedly, people have come to me for pastoral advice in Spanish. I did study Spanish, a beautiful language, back in my time as a student in St. John's Seminary, but not since. I am embarrassingly rusty. So, beginning in mid-July 2017, I will be journeying to Spain and taking a month of Spanish, ending in mid-August.
- (2) I had a two-week taste of the pilgrimage to Santiago on the Portuguese route, two years ago with Fr. Jim Clarke. It was *wonderful*, and too short. So, beginning on Saturday, August 19th, 2017, I will start walking the roughly 810 kilometers / 503 miles, starting in Irun, on the border of France and Spain. I had originally planned to walk with friends, but for a variety of reasons, they have had to withdraw. So, it will be a time to be alone with the Lord. I am wondering if God is behind that. During this journey I will keep in touch with you all on Facebook, and I will be carrying your prayers with me. I'll ask for them from you when we get a little closer to my departure.
- (3) I hope to do some writing. I've started a little project, which may turn into a book, drawing on pilgrimage themes in the Scriptures. We'll see if anything comes of that. I will probably do the writing back here in California in some hidden away place.
- (4) I will inevitably do some traveling. I may go to Mallorca, to see St. Junipero Serra's home town, and maybe South America. My plans are still in process, so we'll see.

I will return to the parish by December so that I can celebrate Advent and Christmas with you. I love Advent, and can't conceive of being anywhere but Camarillo with you when it starts.

The Archdiocese will pay for the Spanish studies. I have been saving up and am able to pay for everything else. God has been very good to me, as have you all. Four priests have agreed to minister to you while I'm away: Fr. Kevin McCracken who you know, Fr. Ron Hoye, who you may recall from a mission a few years ago, and Fr. John Boll and Fr. Liam McCarthy, retired priests from the Sacramento diocese.

The start of my sabbatical is still six months away, but I didn't want you to be left out of the loop on my plans. As you can guess, I'm *very* excited, yet doing everything I can to remain in the present moment ... a very good place to remain, I might add, because of all of you and God's continuous outpouring of love.




