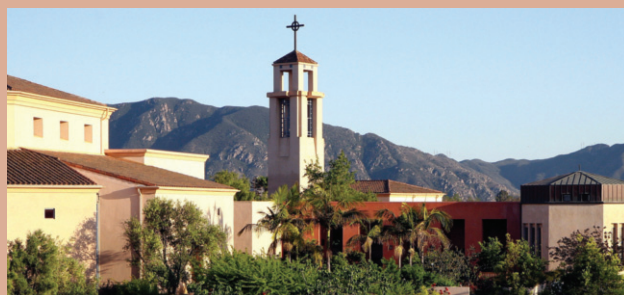

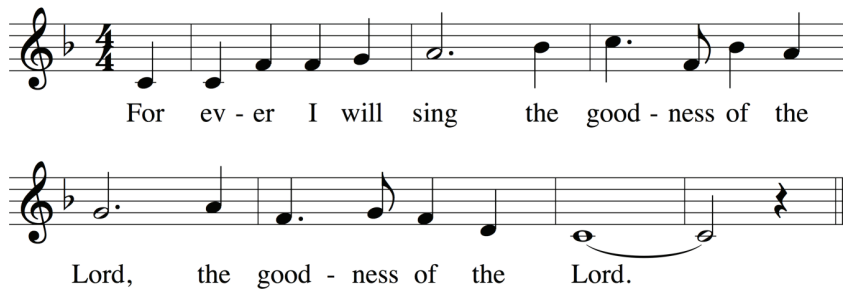

Remembering Who We Are ... Considering What Will Be ...

Inevitably, when celebrating anniversaries, we end up looking both backward and forward. We bring out pictures to remember how we once looked. We count up the years and ponder just how many years we might have left. It can be a useful kind of reflection.

So, looking back, I can remember, as a student at the seminary, back in the '70s before Padre Serra was established, that there were orange groves, unprofitable Valencia trees, growing where the parish now stands. There was a fire pit in the middle of Upland Road across from the southeasternmost corner of the parish. Between that fire pit and Santa Rosa was farmland and undeveloped hillside where the coyotes would howl. No one, at that time, could have guessed how much Camarillo would grow, and what would happen to that land.

Padre Serra Parish started humbly, guests of the seminary, operating offices out of Fr. Liam's home, where I now live, and then in office buildings in town. We should never forget that we existed without a building, without a campus. We *always* need to remind ourselves that Padre Serra Parish is *not* a place ... we're a people. Our buildings are noteworthy, but we are *much* more than the buildings.

The first parishioners were brave souls who left behind the comforts of an established parish. They were also generous, building, in time, an extraordinarily large and beautiful church far larger than their own initial needs, preparing for those that would follow after. When the last building of the parish is built, whenever that will be, we'll need to hang onto that forward-thinking generosity, bravely and generously considering what those who have yet to come may need.

The first leaders of the parish, when they were considering what things might look like, broke all the rules. There would be no altar rail, and the tabernacle would be in its own chapel; the altar would be in the center, not the end; people would sit facing each other around the table of the Lord; the church doors would open onto a plaza, and not the street; all the ministers, including the priest, deacon and altar servers, would sit together with the assembly, clearly the one Body of Christ. All the rules that were broken achieved a greater good. If we could maintain that creativity, that early flexibility, that unwillingness to settle for the ways that things have always been done, who knows what we might think up next?

After the first wave of construction, came a second: the Serra Center was constructed to meet extraordinary needs: large meals, faith formation, entertainment and worship. I haven't been to every parish, but I've been to many, and the Serra Center is special. The dreamers and the supporters didn't settle when they planned this building. When we consider what we will do in the future, be it a building, a program, a ministry, a way of worshipping, a manner of serving, I hope we don't ever start settling. Let's keep dreaming big dreams, beautiful dreams, inspiring hope, and initiating new ways to care, so that peoples yet unknown might come to encounter Jesus, and be his disciples.

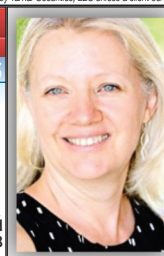

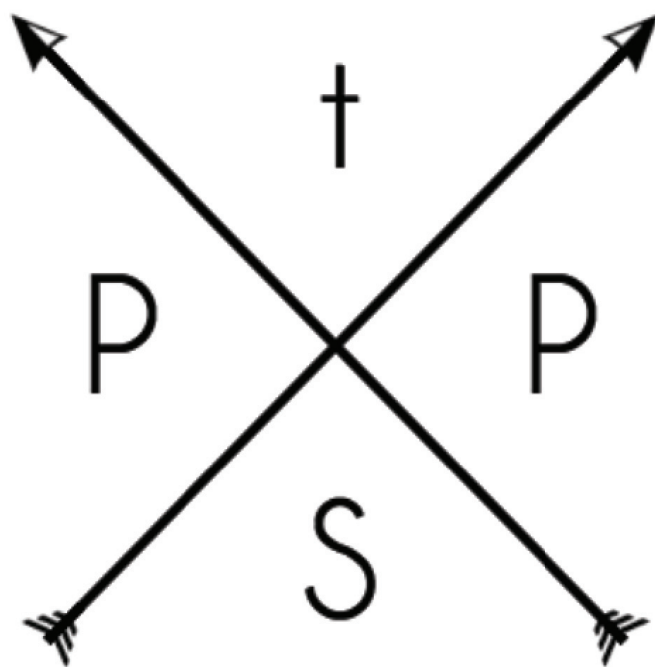
