

Today we hear in John's Gospel one of the most recognized quotes from scripture, John 3:16: "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son." Immediately following this verse we hear, "so everyone who believes in him *might* not perish," "*might* have eternal life" and the world "*might* be saved through him." The "*might*" suggests we also have our part to do.

Our part all began in a galaxy far, far away, or more accurate yet, a Big Bang nearly fifteen billion years ago when God's love for creating began.
