Dear Friends,

Reflecting over today's readings, I think about families; the way you can recognize someone's family members because they may share similar physical traits, characteristics or mannerisms. Others share the same love and enthusiasm for an activity like a sport, music or cooking. We often hear expressions such as "she is her mother's daughter" or "like father, like son." I believe that is what Jesus is reminding us of today. "If you know me, then you will also know my Father. I am in the Father and the Father in me." "I am the Truth the Way and the Life."

God is ever faithful! He keeps his promises.

Most recently I experienced this Gospel with the passing of my grandmother. My grandmother was a devout Catholic attending daily Mass, saying her rosaries and sharing with me about our faith. In the last few years of her life because of all her health complications and Alzheimer's, conversations were limited. Yet with a little help she could still say all her prayers and even sing her favorite church songs, this was not the case with other things. In the last two weeks of her life she told my mother and anyone who would listen, that she was ready, she wanted to see God and Our Mother Mary.

My mother's response was to pray to the Sacred Heart of Jesus to come and take her home. God is faithful and keeps his promises ... "Even if your mother were to forget you, I will not forget you!" (Isa.49:15) My grandmother was unable to remember any of us, but she never forgot about God! I know Jesus came and lead her home. She now dwells in the house of the Father. Even in the haze of her disease, she was faithful in her unwavering faith and trust in God. She preached this faith to her last moment. The faithful routines and reminders of her lifelong faith surpassed even the most difficult of diseases in her Alzheimer's. Her faith was etched into her soul and into her memory until her final days.

The joy of the Resurrection, as we know can not be contained into one day, but celebrated in for the whole Easter Season. Our joy on this Mother's Day weekend is for all our mothers who are with us, and the ones that have gone before us with our Lord to help

prepare that place for us. I want to wish all the mothers who so diligently give of themselves in every way for their children, a Bouquet of Blessings.
