Faith Formation for Children and Teens at Padre Serra!

Join the more than 600 children and teens enrolled in Faith Formation after school!

Little Church ~ For children age 3 through kindergarten, during Sunday mass at 9:00am and 11:00am. Children make friends and learn about God and our Catholic faith in a preschool style environment through stories, prayer, songs, crafts and snacks. This is a co-op style ministry; parents help about four times a year. This 'helping' is a beautiful opportunity to meet other parents and your child's friends.

Spark! ~ For children in grades 1 through 5 where 'sparks' of faith turn into hearts on fire for Jesus! Lessons are written and prepared by our wonderful Faith Formation Coordinators, sessions are taught by parent volunteers. We provide training and mentoring to ensure you are comfortable, everyone is enriched and having a good time.

Spark! - Grades 1 and 2 ~ Children meet in small groups of 10, with 2 adults and a teen to learn about and grow in their relationship with Jesus and their understanding of our faith traditions, prayers and practices through games, crafts and hands-on lessons.

Spark! - Grades 3, 4 and 5 ~ These children meet in small groups of 12, with 2 adults and a teen to learn about our Catholic faith in a way that fosters fun, fellowship and discipleship with a focus on service to the poor and the meaning of the gospel message in their daily lives. Grade 5 studies the bible.

Three:Sixteen ~ These kids, grades 6, 7 and 8, have a blast reading scripture, playing, praying and being crazy. They have an equal focus on bible study and building community with one another. The name is from the gospel of John 3:16!

4:12 (pronounced four one two) ~ High school teens meet weekly to make connections, share their insights and concerns, and grow in faith. They gather with young adult small group leaders and our Youth Minister. The name is from the first book of Timothy.

First Reconciliation and First Communion ~ After a minimum of two consecutive years of the whole family participating in Faith Formation, children in grades 1 through 8 who are ready to receive their First Reconciliation (Confession) and First Communion, attend 2 half-day retreats with their parents to prepare for these holy sacraments.

Youth Confirmation ~ This two-year process for high school teens includes Sunday sessions, hands-on ministry, large and small group faith sharing, community events, retreats and service experiences.

We are the Encounter

My Dear Parish Family,

If you knew you were seeing the people closest to you for the very last time, what would you say? Would it be words of wisdom, something sentimental, maybe marching orders? In today's Gospel, Matthew 28:16-20, we hear Jesus' last words to the apostles before he ascends into heaven. What did Jesus think/know was the most important message to convey to his loved ones?

He began with, "Go and make disciples of all nations." Jesus empowered them — and us — to carry on his ministry. That means share our faith with all those we meet. By our example, in how we treat people in every moment of every day, we teach, proclaim and are Jesus to all we meet. It might sound challenging and certainly for the apostles it was extraordinary. For us, because they blazed the trail, we have the example of their incredible courage; we have the model of Jesus himself and we have unbelievable opportunities to love greatly and broadly, globally, for us ... it is a piece of cake ... or it could be if we believe it. St. Pope John Paul II cautioned that, "secularism and materialism have weakened many people's ability to respond to the Spirit and discern God's loving call." If we can work on setting worldly distractions aside we will see and hear the Holy Spirit within. We have been given the power to continue Jesus' work in our circles, with our family, especially our children, and friends and all those we meet.

If we simply ask ourselves continually throughout the day, 'where is Jesus in this?' we will see him everywhere, because he is everywhere. Watering the yard — Jesus is present in the time-out from our busy week to see up close the beauty that is God in nature, to listen to what he is saying to our hearts. Washing the dishes — Jesus is present in the aftermath of mealtime, in the satisfaction of the sharing. We are thankful that we have food to eat and family and friends to eat with. The more dishes and pots and pans there are is a trophy to the feast that was enjoyed, the sharing of food and conversations, the moments of being present to one another, sharing our stories, struggles, joys and faith. Jesus is present at work where by our labor we contribute to something greater than ourselves. We pay our share of taxes that helps our state, our country and the poor. We earn income that connects us to the global economy, enables us to take care of ourselves and to help others. Jesus is present when we are stuck in traffic and at red lights, when we are waiting at the ball field and the doctor's office, the carpool line and ATM machine. He is present in every conversation, every smile, every look and every touch every day.

Moreover, he is present in us. Matthew tells us Jesus' last words were "... behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age." More than his witness, we are in fact Jesus' presence. Jesus lives in us. That means that how we treat one another matters. What we teach our children matters. Love, kindness and truth matter. Every encounter with another human being is an encounter with Jesus.

How does that re-order our priorities? Share about one thing you would like to do to be more aware, more connected with Jesus within you? How will you express that and to whom? What will your last words be?




