Our Gospel this week challenges us with a counter-cultural idea – “The greatest among you must be your servant. Whoever exalts himself will be humbled; but whoever humbles himself will be exalted.” In our world today where there is so much emphasis placed on titles and accolades, how do we humble ourselves and serve those around us?

We can always look to the saints. One favorite is St. Therese of Lisieux, “The Little Flower.” St. Therese wrote, “What matters in life is not great deeds, but great love.” She lived a life of attention to others. She believed in living as one flower among all the other flowers in God’s garden.

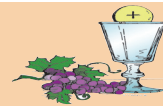
