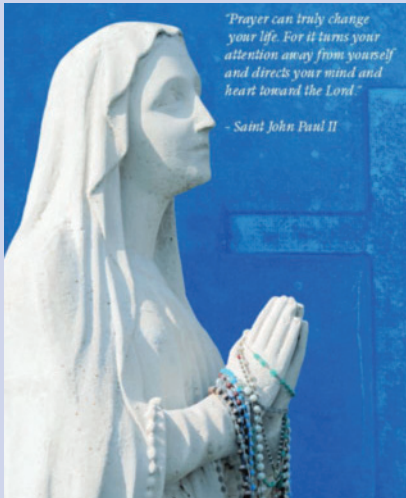

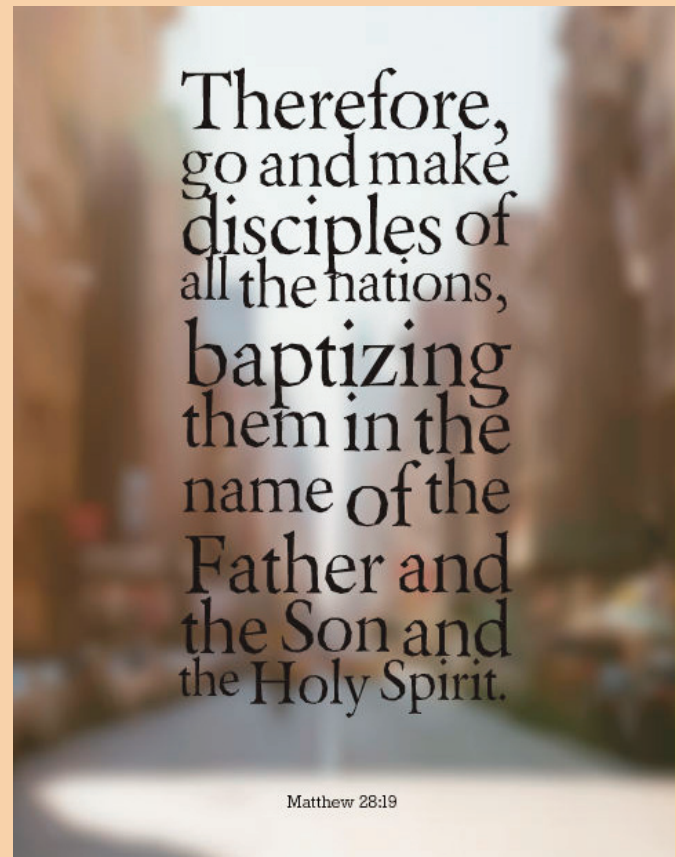
## **Everyday Evangelization for Busy People** **Tuesday, November 7** **6:30pm refreshments** **7:00pm presentation** **Serra Center**



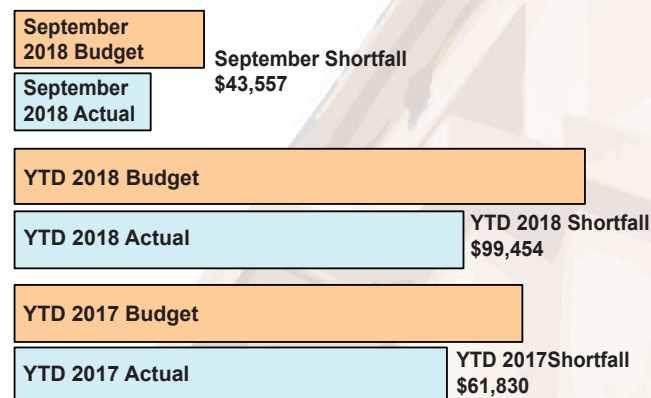

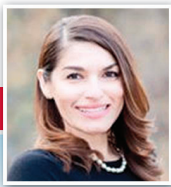
